We know how much email and information families are bombarded with, so we are working hard to achieve a balance: keeping all parents informed while avoiding unnecessary communications. In order to reach as many families as possible in the most convenient way, we use a variety of formats and forums to communicate with you. Here's what to expect this year:

In Person

Nothing beats good old-fashioned face-time! We hold monthly meetings that ALL parents, teachers, and staff are invited to attend. In order to make the meetings accessible to all schedules, the meetings alternate between evening and morning each month. This year, we have a goal of increased attendance at our meetings. ★New! Text Messaging

This year we will be rolling out a new text messaging service called "Remind" that enables you to opt-in to receive text messages regarding important announcements, reminders, and updates. This service enables us to reach even more families in the most convenient way possible. Your beginning-of-year packet includes a separate flyer with information about how to sign up. The service is free, but standard text message rates from your carrier may apply, so the PTO will maintain a guideline of sending no more than 2 school-wide text announcements per week. This service is completely optional, but we hope you will find it helpful.
