



We are seeking volunteers to deliver the Junior Achievement program to your son/daughter's classroom. If you are not familiar, Junior Achievement is a volunteer delivered program that focuses on work-readiness, entrepreneurship and financial literacy skills. Volunteers are provided with a kit with the lessons and materials needed to deliver the program. The lessons are developed at age appropriate levels with relevant, hands-on experiences. There are 5 sessions, 45 minutes each, which are delivered over the course of 5 weeks. The dates/times of these sessions are scheduled at a convenient time between you and your teacher. In past years, the JA sessions for grades 3-5 typically have not started until after PSSAs are completed (late April). For volunteers new to the program, there is a quick training session to help you get familiar with the program.
